**Understanding a High Level of Attainment*

The DfE have set the threshold for a 'high' level of attainment in 2016 at 110.

Understanding Progress Scores

Progress scores will be centred around 0, with most schools within the range of -5 to +5.

The Average Progress score informs us how much progress the children have made between the end of KS1 (Yr 2) and the end of KS2 (Yr6). Anything above -5 is considered to be within the range of 'expected progress'.
