Note from Mrs Durrant 19th June

Dear parents,

It has been a busy couple of weeks with more children returning from Reception, Year 1 and Year 6. Thank you to those parents who expressed an interest last week in returning their Year 2, 3, 4 and 5 child – your responses helped us to plan phase 2 of our return.

We are pleased to announce that we have the capacity to open up the school to those children who answered 'yes' for the week beginning 29.6.2020 for the last 3 weeks of school. Those parents have received a letter today confirming this and more information will follow next week.

We know it has been a difficult decision for some on whether to let your child return, however if you replied 'no' or did not respond then a place has not been allocated for your child. As you can appreciate, there are many logistics to calculate with staff to pupil ratios and space available so we will not be able to take on any late comers we are afraid as our plan has been formed based on these numbers.

Therefore, from the week beginning 29.6.2020 all children learning from home will be working from the same lessons that the other children are taking part in school using the Google Classroom only. No paper packs will be available for the last 3 weeks of term. We will still continue with the fortnightly calls to see how you are and Zoom calls if you wish to join in.

I'm sure you will join me in thanking the staff as it is only due to their positivity that we have been able to offer this provision. A school is not a school without the children and we cannot wait for more to return.
