DROP OFF AND PICK UP TIME SLOTS

In order to avoid queues outside the gates at drop off and pick up we need parents to use the 10 minute time slots. Please avoid queuing early. The registers are not shutting until 9:15am each day so no child will be recorded as late before that point.
