Snacks at break time

Infant children get daily fruit supplied by the government. Reception and Year 1 do not need to bring in a snack of their own, as they do not have a specific break time and they visit the snack/fruit bars in class as part of their free flow and 'Explore and Learn' time. Year 2 children do have a specified break time and may bring in a healthy snack if they wish, although they will also have access to the government fruit. The juniors do not get free fruit from the government, as it is an infant initiative only so they may bring in healthy snacks, e.g. fruit, cereal bars.
