### **Breakfast Club price increase**

Unfortunately, we have had to make the decision to raise the cost of Breakfast Club to £4 per session from September 2022. We have not taken this decision lightly, but with the increased cost of food and utilities, we are unable to continue to run Breakfast Club at the current price. Our Breakfast Club does not make a profit, but we are responsible for making sure that we break even each year. We have reviewed prices at other schools in the area and still feel that we offer great value for money; especially with our starting time of 7.30am. Thank you for your understanding.

### **Exemption parking permit**

The Street Safe scheme will be coming into force in September 2022, which will restrict people from parking down the street. Parents were sent a letter for regarding this on the 17<sup>th</sup> June.

To apply for an exemption permit, go to <https://www.havering.gov.uk/parkingpermits> and select 'buy a permit through MiPermit'.

Scroll down to 'School Street Access Virtual Permits' and select what is appropriate to you, read all the relevant information and then press 'Continue'. You will need to enter all your details.

### **Wheelchair needed!**

If anyone has a wheelchair and would like to donate it to the school to be used for First Aid then please contact the Office on 01708 225202. This would be used to transport children/adults to First Aid, where there is a concern for walking, and so ideally would need to be adult size and in good working order.
