## **Street Safe**

This scheme is continuing which restricts people from parking down the street at drop off and pick up times. To apply for an exemption permit, go to <a href="https://www.havering.gov.uk/parkingpermits">https://www.havering.gov.uk/parkingpermits</a> and select 'buy a permit through MIPermit'. Scroll down to 'School Streets Access Virtual Permits' and select what is appropriate to you, read all the relevant information and then press 'continue'. You will need to enter all of your details.

You will need to reapply even if you had a permit last year.
