## JOPSPA Colour Run – Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2024

This will be a non-uniform day where pupils are to wear as much white as they can (even if they are not participating). There is no guarantee the paint will come out so be warned.

Lessons will finish at 2:15pm and the children will be watching a film in class. Junior gate will open at 2:15pm and parents will be asked to walk around the back of the school field and go to their child's classroom to collect (even infant classes).

Parents can choose to:

- Collect from 2:15pm and go straight home.
- Collect from 2:15pm and support the race in the spectators part of the field.
- Collect from 2:15pm and take their child to their race.
- Wait until normal pick up times.

Y5/6 Children who walk home alone who are not taking part in the race will be dismissed at 3:10pm when they can either go home or watch the race from the spectator part.

There will be 4 different coloured wrist bands according to the time slots 2:15pm/ 2:45pm/ 3:15pm/ 3:45pm. These will be given to your child Friday morning in class for all bookings.

The 2:45pm slot was mostly for pupils who have an after school club to go to or are in Year 5/6 and walk home alone. School staff will supervise these children during their run.

Goggles/ sunglasses and white T-shirt must be worn and this is parent's responsibility to ensure this happens. Parents you are responsible for your child before, during and after the race.

Infant bikes and scooters will be brought to the classrooms where parents will collect from as the infant playground will not be open.

Refreshments will be on sale in the spectator part of the course – cash only please.

There will be toilets available for **children only**, which will be the Year 5 and 6 toilets, which you can access from the junior playground.
